

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE  
PAMLICO COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN  
FOR THE TOWN OF  
MINNESOTT BEACH, NORTH CAROLINA**

**WHEREAS**, Pamlico County, the municipalities within Pamlico county, the NCDOT Transportation Planning Branch and the Down East RPO actively worked to develop a transportation plan for Pamlico County and the municipalities; and

**WHEREAS**, the County and Towns and the Department of Transportation are directed by North Carolina General Statutes 136-66.2 to reach an agreement for highway, transit, bicycle, and pedestrian systems that will serve present and anticipated volumes of traffic in and around the county; and

**WHEREAS**, it is recognized that the proper movement of traffic, the provisions of transit opportunities, and the safety of bicycle and pedestrians within and through the town of Minnesott Beach is a highly desirable element of the comprehensive plan for the orderly growth and development of the town; and

**WHEREAS**, after a full study of the plan, and following a public hearing, the town Commissioners of Minnesott Beach feel it to be in the best interest of Minnesott Beach to adopt the plan elements that are within the town limits pursuant to General Statutes 136-66.2;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Pamlico County Comprehensive Transportation Plan as shown on the attached maps dated September 30, 2009, be approved and adopted as a guide in the development of the highway, transit, bicycle, and pedestrian systems and the same is hereby recommended to the North Carolina Department of Transportation for its subsequent adoption:
