15	Connections are at-grade intersections for most major and minor cross streets			*		
16	Driveways allowed - primarily right-in/right-out; consolidation and sharing access is encouraged			*

18	Examples: US 1 in Raleigh, NC 55 (Holly Springs Bypass), US 70 from Clayton to Garner			*		
19	Balanced mobility and access				*	*
20	25 to 55 mph				*	*
21	Cross section: minimum 2 lanes, no median; includes facilities with a continuous left turn lane				*	*
22	Connections are at-grade intersections				*	*
23	Driveways allowed with full movements; consolidate and share access when possible				*	*
