Finalize Draft Vision and Goals

Sarah handed out the draft of the Vision and Goals, which was put together based on discussions in the last committee meeting. The Vision Statement was compiled primarily from the MTP vision, with minor edits from those discussions. The Goals were compiled from examples chosen in the last meeting, in addition to other suggestions. One minor change was made to the draft in this meeting.

Review Modeled Roads Map

Sarah displayed a large map of the MPO area and the roads that are included in the model. The committee reviewed the map for accuracy and any inconsistencies or corrections that were needed. The committee also added a few roads to be studied.

Begin Public Survey Development

Sarah handed out a set of example survey questions to begin the discussion. The committee discussed question formats and agreed that a yes/no format was good as well as possibly picking a top 2 format. It was decided to break up the questions into 4 sections for roadway, transit, bicycle, and pedestrian questions. The committee reviewed parts of the example questions and chose some to include. It was also decided to ask about responders' age, gender, and live/work locations, but not income or ethnicity. There was also discussion about how to form questions to gauge interest vs. financial support. It was agreed that Sarah would draft an outline to get the ideas on paper, and next meeting the committee can better refine the questions and format.

The next meeting will be at 2:00pm on Wednesday, March 26.
