

Washington Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP)

Attendees: Jerry Rhodes -Washington County Manager, Bill Sexton, Jonathan Taylor, Hemal Shah- TPB, and Angela Welsh-ARPO RPO Coordinator

Hemal discussed the socio-economic data which was presented to the Washington County Board of Commissioners on July 7, 2014.

She then went on to explain the volume and capacity deficiencies from 2014 to 2040 and there were two small segments in Plymouth which were projected to be near capacity by 2040.

The steering committee did not want a Bypass recommended around Plymouth. A median with a left turn only would be acceptable but they did not want traffic routed around Plymouth.

The steering committee asked that Hemal create an inset of Plymouth to show the crash history.

The steering committee also asked about the 32 connector being located on the south side of US 64 and to look closer at Morratock Road because it is very narrow and has bad turns. It is also an area the County has slated for economic Development due to the airport being located there.

The steering committee decided to hold the public workshop on October 6 from 4 pm – 7 pm. Angela was to provide advertising information to the County by September 15 as well as secure a meeting location.
