Subject: Capital Area MPO (Metropolitan Planning Org.) Functional Classification System Revisions for NC 98 Business

Dear Ms. Stark:

The North Carolina Department of Transportation has worked cooperatively with the Capital Area MPO to revise the Functional Classification System. The Capital Area MPO Functional Classification System was last updated on October 15, 2008. The changes conform as per 23-CFR-470. This Functional Classification change was an adjustment for the realignment of NC 98 Business caused by the partial completion of the Wake Forest Bypass (R-2809).

Functional Classification revisions and mileage for NC 98 Business:

- 1. NC 98 Business, NC 98 to the existing NC 98 Business, has been added as an Urban Collector. (0.11 Mile)
- 2. Old NC 98, NC 98 east of SR 2053 to NC 98 Business west of SR 5166, has been deleted as an Urban Collector. (0.33 Mile)
- 3. SR 5166, NC 98 Business to end of new road at water treatment plant, has been added as an Urban Local. (0.11 Mile)
