Eligible Roadside Feature Activities

Drainage

- Replace/Repair Paved Lateral Ditches
- Line/Repair Crossline Pipes
- Inlet Repair/Retrofit
- Shoulder Drains

Traffic

- Pavement Markings
- Pavement Markers
- Signs
- Guardrail
- Lighting
- Attenuators

Contracting Requirements

- Individual Projects –
Stand-Alone projects on eligible activities
- Inclusive Projects
Work performed in conjunction with Bridge Preservation or Pavement Preservation activities

Contracting Requirements

- Condition of feature must be below the performance measure target for most recent Maintenance Condition Assessment
- Division can perform assessments on proposed corridor using MCAP criteria. Assets must be below the performance measure target
- Assets within the corridor do not meet current design standards in accordance with MUTCD

Scenario 1 – Stand Alone Contracts

- **Lighting**
Do I need to upgrade or replace my interchange or roadway lighting?
- **Crossline Pipes**
Address a series of pipes in a corridor
- **Paved Ditches**
Address a series of ditches in a corridor
- **Striping**
Address a corridor cyclically every 3 years

Scenario 2 – Inclusive with Pavement

- **Markings and Markers**

Are you treating the pavement and need to replace markings and markers?

- **Guardrail**

Are you treating the pavement and need to upgrade or replace the guardrail?

- **Paved Ditches**

Are your treating the pavement and the paved ditches need addressing?

Scenario 3 – Inclusive with Bridge

- **Guardrail**

Are you doing bridge work and need to address the guardrail ends?

- **Crossline Pipes**

Are you addressing a series of bridges and it is appropriate to address crossline pipes in the corridor?

Individual or Stand-Alone Contracts

- Assessments base on MCAP criteria
- SRMU will assist you if needed
- Document your needs and thoughts in selecting treatments

Inclusive or Conjunction Contracts

- Pavements or Bridges will “drive” the location and roadside feature work is “effective in same corridor area”
- Document your needs and thoughts when selecting treatments
