SUBJECT: Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) Posted Notices for Local Confinement

Facility or State or Federal Correctional Facility

In accordance with Section 3 of Session Law 2017-179, the NCDOT Division of Aviation has developed guidelines for the content and dimensions of posted notices to mark boundaries in accordance of Section 1 of the session law.

## **Posted Notice Guidelines**

The posted notices should include the following:

- 1. A depiction of an unmanned aircraft system (UAS or drone) with restricted area symbol.
- 2. The message "NO DRONES OVER PRISONS" or "NO DRONES OVER JUVENILE FACILITIES"
- 3. A reference to N.C. General Statute §15A-300.3
- 4. The restricted distances from the confinement or correctional facility per §15A-300.3 (a) 500 horizontal feet and 250 vertical feet
- 5. The sign dimensions should be a minimum of 11 inches by 17 inches

It should be noted that the §15A-300.3 (a) states "Posted notices shall be conspicuously posted not more than 100 yards apart along a marked boundary and comply with Department of Transportation guidelines".
