Important Information on operating an UAS in North Carolina

- North Carolina UAS Operator permit is required for commercial and government UAS/Drone operations in North Carolina, along with the FAA Remote Pilot License.
- Passing the UAS Knowledge Test is a requirement for obtaining a permit.
- No person shall operate an UAS in the State for commercial purposes unless the person is in possession of a permit.
