The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) wishes to express its full support for the I-95 Bridges application under the United States Department of Transportation's Bridge Investment Program (BIP). The I-95 Bridges Project seeks BIP Bridge Project Grant funds to allow NCDOT to replace aging and deficient bridges on the vital I-95 corridor in Johnston County, North Carolina.

The State of North Carolina understands the importance of maintaining a sustainable freight network. I-95 is a part of the National Highway System, a Strategic Transportation Corridor, and a key route for tourists and goods throughout the east coast of the United States.

The project will replace four bridges which date to the initial construction of I-95 in the late 1950s. All the structures are listed as functionally obsolete or structurally deficient.

The I-95 Bridges Project is reflected in our mission statement:


Connecting people, products and places safely and efficiently with customer focus, accountability and environmental sensitivity to enhance the economy and vitality of North Carolina.
