

Consultants Access for Bentley User Guide





Licensing

NCDOT requires that contractors and consultants provide their own ProjectWise licenses. Bentley does offer subscription and licensing options for ProjectWise. The following is information on the license types and offerings provided by Bentley:

In 2023 Bentley updated the ProjectWise entitlements as new capabilities were added to the base functionality of ProjectWise. Below is a mapping of the previous ProjectWise Visas to the updated entitlements. Please use this matrix to identify which entitlement you may need to access NCDOT's ProjectWise datasource; if you are unsure, please reach out to the NCDOT ProjectWise Administrator or your Bentley Account Manager:



If your organization is a current ProjectWise User, you should contact your License Administrator or Bentley Account Manager to request access to the proper ProjectWise entitlement.

If your organization is not a currently ProjectWise User, you can purchase a 12-month Virtuoso Subscription which offers a way to lease a 12-month license of Bentley software. Included in every Virtuoso subscription is access to training. This option does not require a contract with Bentley as subscriptions are purchased through the Bentley eStore Virtuosity. Bentley does offer discounts to certified small and disadvantaged businesses, please inquire with your North Carolina contact about how to apply the discount to any purchases made through Virtuosity.

Software Requirements

Currently NCDOT uses ProjectWise Explorer (ver10.0.3.453). This product requires a license. Connection Client (11.00.05.43 or higher) is also necessary. Both products can be downloaded from the Bentley web site at https://connect.bentley.com. There is no licensing required for Connection Client.


Installations


Downloading and Installing

Download ProjectWise Client Software

- 1) To download ProjectWise Client software, click on the following link: https://connect.bentley.com
- 2) If not logged in, type your Email and Password. If you have not registered, you must do so before you can log in by clicking *Don't have an account? Register now.*, located at the bottom of the box.




3) Once logged in, scroll to the bottom of the page. If you have access to download software, you will see a box labeled Software Downloads in the My Services section of the page.



If you do not see this option, contact your Bentley account manager

4) Search for "ProjectWise Explorer" in the upper right corner Search for product... box.



5) Choose ProjectWise Explorer Client from the list


6) Set dropdowns as seen below



7) Click Apply

8) Choose download on the top option. (Version 10.00.03.453)




- 9) Navigate to the location of the downloaded file in Windows Explorer.
- 10) Double click on "pwclt100003453en.exe".
- 11) This should start the "Installation Wizard"
- 12) Accept the default installation location, read and accept the license agreement, then click "Next".

The ProjectWise Explorer installer delivers both 64-bit and 32-bit components.

13) Under "**Select feature to install**" the ProjectWise Explorer item should be preselected. Check the check box next to each feature you want to install, then click "**Install**".

Installation of the selected features begins. When installation is complete, click "Finish"

ProjectWise Network Configuration




- 1) Open "ProjectWise Explorer"
- 2) Click on "Network Configuration Settings..." under the Tools pulldown.
- 3) On the Datasource Listing tab:

Name – Can be anything. I have used "NCDOT" Hostname - ncdot-pw.bentley.com Port - 5800

Enter the data in the boxes.


Click Add then Close



4) Once the settings have been added refresh your screen by right-clicking on "ProjectWise Explorer Datasources" then clicking Refresh. You should see the three datasources:

NCDOT Development, NCDOT **Production** and **NCDOT Training | QC**


But consultant access will only be provided to the NCDOT Production Datasource.



If you do not see these datasources, please contact your IT Department to open port 5800 on your firewall. If they are still not visible, contact us at dot.pwsupport@ncdot.gov.

5) To log in a datasource you can:

Click the Datasource dropdown and the Log In... OR Right-click on the datasource name and choose Log In... OR Click on the arrow to the left of the datasource OR Double-click on the datasource name



You may not be able to log into **NCDOT Training | QC**

- a. Choose **NCDOT Production** from the Datasource dropdown.
- b. Choose *Bentley ISM* from the Authentication dropdown. The User Name and Password will gray out.
- c. Click *Log in*. This should log you in.

If you attempt to log in to ProjectWise Explorer without being logged in to Connection Client then Connection Client will open up once you Click *Log in* and you must log in then.


Using ProjectWise Explorer

When logging into ProjectWise for the first time you will be prompted to create a working directory. Click "Yes" to create this directory.




This will be the local working directory used by ProjectWise. Do not open or delete files directly from this directory. Use the Local Document Organizer inside of ProjectWise Explorer to manage the local working directory. You will only see this prompt the first time you log in to ProjectWise Explorer.


After logging in, you should see the following:



Each division will contain work areas to represent projects within that division and each work area

should have basically the same folder structure.





Opening a file can be done by double-clicking the file.

Work areas using a managed workspace will automatically download any new standards needed.

Work areas not using a managed workspace will use whatever standards are on your local drive.

For information on how to use other functionality within ProjectWise Explorer, you can access the help.
