
Nationwide and General Permits – Checklist and Guidance

When do I use this?

It is recommended to start using this guide when the project is one year from permit due date to identify and ensure all required elements of a permit application are obtained for an on-time submittal of the permit application.

Format of this guidance

This PDF can be used to aggregate a application package as the pieces are acquired. The checklists pages can then be deleted once they are no longer needed, and you'll be left with the complete attachment ready to upload to the ePCN.
