Attached are two (2) new approved jurisdiction-related forms that are now available for your use. Effective immediately, these two new forms should be used in place of the old appendices to RGL 16-01.

Regulatory Guidance Letter (RGL) 16-01, Appendix 1 and Appendix 2.

- ENG 6247: Request for Jurisdictional Determination
- ENG 6249: Preliminary Jurisdictional Determination

Requestors do not have to use ENG 6247 to request a JD. However, we encourage requestors to use it. The form helps provide the information we need to fulfill a JD request, but is not required.

Note that for approved JDs (AJDs), there is no change to current procedure.


Also, please note that requestors do not have to sign the PJD form (6249) until after the Corps has verified the PJD, and then the requestor will sign the PJD form and return it to the Corps.
