

ATLAS 2021 Quarter 3 Release Notes

1. Upgrade Esri JavaScript API – Search & Screening

This upgrade will allow ATLAS to stay current with new Esri functionality and resolve a bug related to the drawing of some of the NC Natural Heritage Program layers.

2. Expanded Search & Screening template name to 50 characters – Search & Screening

The Search and Screening template Names can now be 50 characters long.

3. Add error to end of Screening Report for “always run” Layers - Screening

Several GIS layers are selected as “always run” layers to screen against in the Screening tool, but if they don’t load, these do not show up in the error report area at the end of the document. With this update, these layers will now display in the error report section at the end of the PDF if the screening fails for the given layer. These layers are listed below:

- County
- Division
- EPA Level III Ecoregion
- HUC8
- CAMA
- Riparian Buffer
- EPA Level IV Ecoregion
- Airport within 4 miles

4. Rearranged Select by Project ID map elements - Screening

In the Screening tool, the Legend button and the Selection button on the Select By Project ID map collide with one another and overlap with the location search bar. These items are now moved to a fixed location on the map to the left of the location search.

5. Changes to the Hydro report concerning 303(d) streams - Screening

The Hydro report has now been modified to provide specific information on the presence of 303(d) streams based on the ATLAS Hydro layer. Values for “Impaired, 303(d)”, “Impaired, not 303(d)”, “Impaired, might be 303(d)”, and “Not Impaired” are now displayed on the Hydro Report PDF.

6. Timestamps for workbench controls and uploads - Workbench

Time and date of latest control modification now populates next to the question or document upload, beside the name of the last person that modified the control.

7. First version of the External Workbench (No Commenting) - Workbench

External agencies can now view a read-only, static version of each Preconstruction ATLAS Workbench Page. External users can access this through the same project URL on the SharePoint Preconstruction

page(s). Links to documents in the External Collaboration folder are available for external users to access.

8. Document Sets added as a Workbench upload file type - Workbench

Document Sets are now available as an upload file type on the Workbench. Users can upload multiple files as one set that constitute a key deliverable, such as a package of information from a public hearing.
