Dear Secretary Buttigieg,

The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) in cooperation with the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) appreciates your consideration of our joint application for funding under the FY 2022-2023 Wildlife Crossings Pilot Program. Our joint grant application funds a Wildlife Connectivity Corridor Feasibility Study on I-40 in the Pigeon River Gorge, project I-40 SAFE PASSSAGE.

Project I-40 SAFE PASSAGE, facilitated by NCDOT in coordination and cooperation with TDOT, aims to conduct a targeted corridor feasibility study along 28 miles of Interstate 40 within the Pigeon River Gorge on the border of NC and TN. The purpose of the study is to significantly advance our agencies' understanding of the full range of wildlife mitigation opportunities available along this critical roadway. This feasibility study is critical to ensuring future construction projects in the Pigeon River Gorge fully consider wildlife connectivity while reducing wildlife vehicle collisions and improving motor vehicle safety.
