NCDOT WILDLIFE CROSSINGS PILOT PROGRAM 2023 GRANT APPLICATION UWHARRIE CONNECT REQUEST FOR AGENCY SUPPORT

The Wildlife Crossings Pilot Program (WCPP) is a competitive grant program that awards grants to eligible entities for projects with the goal of reducing Wildlife Vehicle Collisions (WVCs) while improving both motorist safety and habitat connectivity for terrestrial and aquatic species.

In the spirit of continued longstanding interagency cooperation, the NCDOT requests your support for UWHARRIE CONNECT (see attached), a WCPP grant application. NCDOT has a successful history of incorporating and constructing wildlife crossings on transportation facilities in North Carolina.
