Subject: Union County. The widening of US 601 from the South Carolina State Line

to North of SR 2105 (Marion Lee Road). NCDOT Division 10. Federal Project No. STP-NHS-601(4), State Project No.8.1690303; TIP No. R-2616.

The purpose of this letter is to request that the North Carolina Ecosystem Enhancement Program (EEP) provide confirmation that you are willing to provide compensatory mitigation for the project in accordance with the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) signed July 22, 2003 by the USACE, the NCDENR and the NCDOT.

The NCDOT proposes to widen US 601 from the South Carolina State Line to North of Marion Lee Road (SR 2105). The proposed project will consist of widening the existing two lane facility to a four-lane facility. The total length is approximately 10.88 miles and will require a minimum of 200 feet of right of way. The let date for this design-build project is currently scheduled for February 21, 2006.

The project is located in the Piedmont Physiographic Province in Union County in the Pee-Dee River basin (Hydrological Cataloguing Unit 03040105).

## Resources Under the Jurisdiction of the Section 404 and 401 of the Clean Water Act.

We have avoided and minimized the impacts to jurisdictional resources to the greatest extent possible. We request that the remaining impacts to jurisdictional resources will be compensated for with mitigation provided by the EEP program. We estimate that 0.149 acres of wetlands and 2,969 linear feet of streams will be impacted, as summarized from table 1.
