Back Creek Stream and Wetland Mitigation Site consisting of a 17.5-acre tract adjacent to Back Creek and two unnamed tributaries between Back Creek Church Road and I-485, northeast of Charlotte, TIP No. R-0967 CA

Description of Activity:

This modification authorizes additional channel restoration activities on Back Creek downstream of the original design limits between Stations 34+75 and 36+50 consisting of bank sloping, construction of a bankfull bench on outside meander bends and debris jam removal. SPECIAL CONDITION: The permittee will fully implement the Back Creek Site Detailed Stream and Wetland Mitigation Plan, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina dated January 2003, plan amendments dated 28 October 2003 and further plan amendments dated November 7, 2005.

An As Built plan will be provided to the Corps of Engineers within 60 days of completion of construction.


