This permit was amended on 3/15/00 with a revised Condition #1.

Major Development in an Area of Environmental Concern pursuant to NCGS 113A-118
- Excavation and/or filling pursuant to NCGS 113-229

Issued to N.C. Department of Transportation, P.O. Box 25201, Raleigh, NC 27611

authorizing development in Beaufort County at Bridge No. 63 on US 264-NC 92 at the Cuckold's Creek crossing as requested in the permittee's application dated dated 9/3/99 including attached workplan drawings, 1 of 8 and 4 through 8 of 8, all dated 7/19/99.

This permit, issued on 2/28/00, is subject to compliance with the application (where consistent with the permit), all applicable regulations, special conditions and notes set forth below. Any violation of these terms may be subject to a fine, imprisonment or civil action; or may cause the permit to be null and void.

Bridge Construction

- 1) If the proposed project will result in relocation of utility lines, then a modification of this permit will be required.
- 2) A portion of the proposed work will take place within property owned by the Norfolk and Southern Railroad. Prior to construction of the proposed bridge and detour structure, a temporary construction easement or letter of consent for this work must be obtained from the Norfolk and Southern Railroad, and a copy of such authorization provided to the N.C. Division of Coastal Management (DCM).

This permit action may be appealed by the permittee or other qualified persons within twenty (20) days of the issuing date. An appeal requires resolution prior to work initiation or continuance, as the case may be.


This permit must be accessible on-site to Department personnel when the project is inspected for compliance.

All work must cease when the permit expires on December 31, 2003
