LeiLani,

The removal of a portion of the causeway resulted in 0.14 acres of riverine swamp forest restoration. The removal of the overhead utility lines resulted in approximately 0.45 acres of riverine swamp forest enhancement. The USACE is satisfied that the 0.223 acres of wetland impact has been adequately mitigated on-site and no additional mitigation is needed.

Last week we discussed the following project:

TIP B-4020

Bridge over Tranter's Creek and Approaches on SR-1403 & SR1567 in Washington USACE Action ill No. SAW -2007 -04084

The original permit covered 0.37 acres of wetland impact with onsite restoration and debiting the Mildred Woods site. The permit modification revised the wetlands impacts to 0.123 acres and eliminated the need for debiting the Mildred Woods site.

The letter from Division dated August 31, 2009 revised the final wetland impacts to 0.223 acres and requested that no further work be required for the onsite mitigation, including no monitoring.

As we discussed, the USACE is satisfied that the 0.223 acres of wetland impact is mitigated by the onsite work completed to date, including removal of the causeway and stabilization with wetland seed mix, and relocation of the overhead powerline in a wetland area adjacent to the project to an underground line.

The debit at Mildred Woods can be eliminated.

No further permit action is required at this time for this project.
