Reference your letters dated April 30, 2014, regarding the Tributaries to Dixon Branch Mitigation Sites #23 and #24 located east of the intersection of I-485 and I-77 in Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina (adjacent to Charlotte Outer Loop from Sta. 376+90 to 378+15 L (Site #23) and from Sta. 378+15 to 379+40 Left of L and Sta. 380+16 to 381+23 Left of L (site # 24)). This site is being utilized by the North Carolina Department of Transportation as compensatory mitigation for impacts to jurisdictional waters of the United States authorized by Department of Army (DA) permit Action ID No. 2001-31321 associated with construction of the Charlotte Outer Loop, TIP No. R-2248D.

By copy of this letter, we concur that you have completed the requirements to monitor these stream mitigation sites for bank stability and survival of planted species on a biannual basis for five years or until success criteria were met. Accordingly, no further monitoring of these sites is required
