Major Development in an Area of Environmental Concern  
pursuant to NCGS 113A-118

Excavation and/or filling pursuant to NCGS 113-229

Issued to N.C. Department of Transportation, 1548 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-1548

Authorizing development in Tyrrell and Washington County at Kendrick Creek, Scuppernon R. & Tyrrell Co.

Drainage District Canal #2, US 64, as requested in the permittee's application letter dated 8/25/03, including the attached workplan drawings (8): 3 dated 7/28/03; and 5 dated as received 8/27/03.

This permit, issued on 10/16/03, is subject to compliance with the application (where consistent with the permit), all applicable regulations, special conditions and notes set forth below. Any violation of these terms may be subject to fines, imprisonment or civil action; or may cause the permit to be null and void.

**R-2548, US 64 from Plymouth to East of Columbia**

- 1) This minor modification authorizes a location adjustment to the temporary work bridge associated with construction of Phase 2 of the Scuppernon River bridge, as depicted on the attached workplan drawings.
- 2) No trees shall be removed as a result of activities authorized by this permit modification.
- 3) The type and number of bents and piles, and the methods of pile installation for the temporary work bridge will remain the same as what has been previously authorized by the active CAMA permit for this project.

This permit action may be appealed by the permittee or other qualified persons within twenty (20) days of the issuing date. An appeal requires resolution prior to work initiation or continuance as the case may be.

This permit must be accessible on-site to Department personnel when the project is inspected for compliance.


Any maintenance work or project modification not covered hereunder requires further Division approval.

**ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS**

**NOTE:** According to the permittee, since the number of piles is the same as originally permitted, the temporary wetland impacts associated with the 30" hollow steel piles being driven will not change as a result of the changes authorized by this modification.

- 4) This minor modification must be attached to the original of Permit No. 166-00, which was issued on 10/30/00, as well as all subsequent modifications and/or letters of refinement, and all documents must be readily available on site when a Division representative inspects the project for compliance.
- 5) All conditions and stipulations of the active permit remain in force under this minor modification unless altered herein.
- 6) This permit modification does not eliminate the need to obtain any additional permits, approvals or authorizations that may be required.
