SUBJECT: Mitigation Plan for the US 117 Highway Project, Duplin County, North Carolina.

This is to advise you that we have met with representatives from the North Carolina Department of Transportation and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service regarding the subject project. During this meeting, an agreement for mitigating bottomland hardwood losses by restoring 30 acres on the Cottle Tract to bottomland hardwoods was reached. The 2.5 acre pocosin loss is to be offset through debiting five acres from the Pridgen Flats Pocosin Mitigation Bank in Sampson County.

Provided this mitigation is carried out in a manner that will ensure successful wetland restoration, we are willing to withdraw our objection to the project.
