The purpose of this letter is to notify you that the Ecosystem Enhancement Program (EEP) has transferred the Jeffrey's Warehouse Mitigation Project (JALO) to NCDOT for project implementation and use of credits. This transfer was effective as of September 30, 2007. JALO was originally developed as an on-site mitigation project and was inadvertently transferred to EEP during the project and credit migration process. NCDOT and EEP jointly discussed the issue and jointly agreed that the JALO project would be returned to NCDOT along with all of its mitigation credits for NCDOT project implementation and mitigation use. This letter confirms that the JALO project has been returned to NCDOT along with all of its mitigation credits.
