Fort Liberty strongly endorses and supports the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) Multimodal Projects Discretionary Grant (MPDG) Program application to improve rural surface transportation in the North Carolina Sandhills Region. NCDOT's Maximizing our Rural Economy on I-74 Project (MORE I-74 Project) will improve 10 miles of US 74 to interstate standards. The Fort Liberty military community will benefit greatly from this transportation network improvement.

The MORE I-74 Project will improve economic competitiveness of multiple historically disadvantaged, persistent poverty, and rural communities along the MORE I-74 Project.
