

# QC/QA Aggregate Sampling and Testing Class – 2012

## Description

**\*Note:**

- Personnel that are to be certified for Aggregate Sampling only will be required to attend the morning session of the class from 8:00 am to 12:00 noon.
- Personnel that are to be certified for Aggregate Sampling and Testing will be required to be precertified in the field by a Technical Trainer from the Soils Laboratory prior to attending the class. They then must attend the full class from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.
- Please contact Mr. Mehdi Haeri at (919)329-4150 at least six weeks prior to the chosen class date and provide him with the technicians' names and the plant sites where the field precertifications will take place. Arrangements will then be made for a Technical Trainer to meet with your personnel at the site.
- A non-refundable application fee of US \$100.00 for attending the Training Course payable to the NCDOT Materials and Tests Unit shall be sent in with the application form.

- The December 6, 2011 date is exam only, no class material will be covered.
- Personnel who have a current QC/QA certification have the option to take the written examination after the Technician Trainer completes the pre-certification process. If the technician demonstrates proficient testing/sampling procedures during the precertification and passes the written examination, he/she will not be required to attend the QC/QA training classes to maintain their certification. However, if the technician fails the written exam he/she will be required to attend the training class.
- **Important** - Prior to a student attending class or taking the written examination for a recertification we must have received the appropriate enrollment form and application fee. A class confirmation letter will be sent for each student attending the training class and the confirmation letter must be presented to the Technical Trainer at the beginning of class. Any technician that has not submitted the proper enrollment form, applicable course fee(s), or fails to provide a copy of the course confirmation letter will not be allowed to attend. NO EXCEPTIONS.
