



NCDOT Request for Temporary Certification - Waiver to Practice

To be temporarily certified for sampling, testing, and inspection of North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) work, a technician shall meet the following requirements:

- The technician shall hold a current certification in good standing from another state transportation agency, NICET, or ACI in the applicable area of inspection – proof of certifications must be **attached** to this form.
- The technician shall not have been de-certified by another state transportation agency or other accrediting body in any area for any reason other than expiration of certification.
- The technician shall be familiar with applicable NCDOT procedures and policies related to sampling, testing, and inspection.
- The technician shall be enrolled in the applicable NCDOT technician certification course(s) to be held within six months of the signature date of this form. Proof of registration should be submitted with this form.
- The technician shall only perform sampling, testing, and inspection of NCDOT work under the responsible charge of North Carolina Department of Transportation.

All certification waiver requests must be approved by the NCDOT State Materials Engineer and **will expire** at the earlier of six months from the date authorized, or unsatisfactory assessments, or the technician's unsuccessful completion of the applicable NCDOT certification course to include one retest attempt.
