SUPPLEMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Refer to the work zone categories description sheet on page 2 of this checklist to identify the correct category for your work zone product.
- 2. Provide a Safety Data Sheet (SDS).
- 3. Provide a Letter of Compliance stating at a minimum: the company name, product name, statement saying it meets the applicable specification(s) and the manufacturer's currently published physical properties and performance characteristics.
- 4. Provide a current Product Specification Sheet.
- 5. Provide a Technical Data Sheet stating at a minimum: product description, technical information, maintenance data, and precaution/limitation(s).
- 6. Category II and Category III products must meet MASH requirements. Supply completed crash tests as directed:
 - a. Portable Signs & Stands Level 3
 - b. All Type III Barricades Level 3
 - c. Temporary Crash Cushions Level 2 or 3 (whichever applies)
 - d. Truck Mounted Impact Attenuators Level 2 or 3 (whichever applies)
 - e. Portable Concrete Barriers Level 3
 - f. Water Filled Barriers Level 2 or 3 (whichever applies)
 - g. Steel Barriers
- 7. Category IV products must submit relevant National Transportation Product Evaluation Program (NTPEP) data.

WZTC Categories Description Sheet

Category I: Lightweight delineating devices

- Cones, tubular markers, flexible delineator posts, plastic drums

Category II: Devices not expected to produce significant vehicular velocity change

- Barricades, portable sign supports, vertical panels, cones with lights

Category III: Devices expected to cause significant velocity changes or potentially harmful impacts to vehicles

- Barriers, fixed sign supports, crash cushions

Category IV: Trailer mounted work zone devices

- Changeable message signs, flashing arrow panels, portable traffic signals, temporary work zone lighting
