

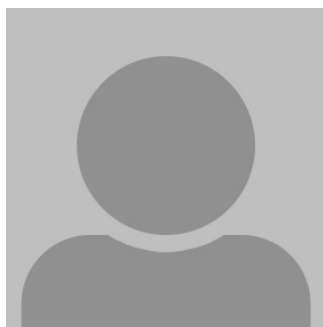
# Pedestrian Access on Curtis Bridge Road

Countless people walk through this location and are required to place their lives in jeopardy to reach sites, such as the local soup kitchen, areas of employment, and the heart of the county, daily.
