3. Receiver agrees that it will not advertise, order for resale, or sell the file(s) furnished hereunder.
4. Receiver agrees that the NCDOT has made every reasonable effort to provide information in a file format which offers cross platform solutions (for both application and file compression). Some NCDOT files are compressed. Compressed files can be identified by a file extension, (e.g., .sit, .bin, .hqx, .zip, or .arc).
5. Receiver agrees that NCDOT cannot be held responsible for problems arising from files which have been converted for use in non-native applications.
