



# Updating your local ORD WorkSpace

WorkSpaces are automatically updated in ProjectWise, but if you're working on a .dgn file on your local machine, you may need to periodically update your Workspace.

1. Delete the "NCDOT\_Connect\_Workspace" folder from your C: drive



Also delete the B-0000 and B-1010 WorkSets from the "Projects" folder if you have them



2. Download the new Workspace from the CADD Consultants page on Connect NCDOT:






### 3. Extract the .zip folder




When the “Extract Compressed Folders” dialogue box appears, make sure to extract to the C: drive



When the “Replace or Skip Files” dialogue box appears, make sure to “Replace the files in the destination”



4. (for NCDOT staff) Run the “AutoTurn Folders” batch file found on the S: drive



5. (optional) Delete the “NCDOT\_CONNECT\_WORKSPACE” .zip file from your “Downloads” folder to save a lot of space
