NC ROUTE CHANGES

Division 1

Bertie County

Add the following routing of NC 42 south and north of Lewiston and Woodville:

NC 11 from the Martin County Line (at Roanoke River), northward to the Hertford County Line.

Delete the following routing of NC 350 and add as a Secondary Road in and north of Aulander:

NC 350 from NC 305 in Aulander, northward to the Hertford County Line.

Delete the Following routing of NC 350 and add as NC 42 in and north of Powellville:

US 13, NC 350 from the intersection of US 13, NC 350 in Powellville, northward to the Hertford County Line.

Delete the following routing of NC 350 and add as NC 42 east of Powellville:

NC 350 from the intersection of US 13, NC 350 in Powellville, eastward to NC 45, in Colerain.

Hertford County

Add the following routing of NC 42 north of Aulander:

NC 11 from the Bertie County Line, northward to NC 11-NC 350.

Delete the following routing of NC 350 and add as NC 42 southwest of Ahoskie:

NC 11-NC 350 from the southwest intersection of NC 11-NC 350, northward to US 13, NC 11-NC 561, in Ahoskie.

Delete the following routing of NC 350 and add as NC 42 in and east of Ahoskie:

US 13, NC 350-NC 561 from the west intersection of US 13, NC 11-NC 350-NC 561, in Ahoskie, eastward to the east intersection of US 13, NC 350-NC 561.

Delete the following routing of NC 350 and add as NC 42 southeast of Ahoskie:

US 13, NC 350 from the intersection of NC 561, southeastward to the Bertie County Line.

Delete the following routing of NC 350 and add as a Secondary Road north of Aulander:

NC 350 from the Bertie County Line, northward to the intersection of NC 11-NC 350.

Division 1 - Continued

Martin County

Delete the following routing of NC 42 and add as NC 142 west and east of Hassell:

NC 42 from NC 11, eastward to the intersection of NC 125-903.

Add the following routing of NC 42 south and north of Oak City:

NC 11 from the intersection of NC 11-42, west of Hassell, northward to the Bertie County Line (at Roanoke River).
