

NO PARKING ORDINANCES

ADOPTION OF TRAFFIC ENGINEERING ORDINANCES

NO PARKING ORDINANCES

Division 11

Avery County

Along both sides of US 221 from a point 0.40 mile west of the Blue Ridge Parkway to a point 0.20 mile west of the Blue Ridge Parkway, northeast of Linville.

Along both sides of US 221 from a point 1000 feet west of SR 1510 to a point 1000 feet east of SR 1510, northeast of Linville.

Along both sides of NC 105 from a point 1.60 miles north of SR 1351 to a point 2.35 miles north of SR 1351, north of Linville.
