The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 20-141.

TEMPORARY SPEED LIMITS

Division 7

Project No. 6.491009 - Guilford County

A 35 mph speed zone on US 220 from the northern corporate limit of Greensboro, a point 0.06 mile south of SR 2343, northward to a point 0.20 mile north of SR 2179, a distance of 0.40 mile, north of Greensboro.

Project No. 9.5070802 - 9.7070811 - Guilford County

A 35 mph speed zone on US 220 from Westridge Road, northward to the northern corporate limit, a point 0.06 mile south of SR 2343, in Greensboro.
