The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinance based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 20-141.

TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT

Division 6

Harnett County

A 45 mph zone on the northbound lanes of I-95 from a point 1.10 miles north of SR 1002 (Long Branch Road), north to US 421-NC 55 (including off-ramp), a distance of 1.10 miles, southeast of Dunn.
