The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 136-18 (5).

NO PARKING ORDINANCES

Division 8

Moore County

Along both sides of SR 1843 from a point 0.25 mile west of NC 22, eastward to a point 1.00 mile east of NC 22, west of Whispering Pines.

Along both sides of NC 22 from a point 0.25 mile south of SR 1843, northward to the south intersection of SR 1897, west of Whispering Pines.
