Delete the following routing of SR 1006 and add as NC 27 southeast of Buies Creek:

SR 1006 from US 421, northward to NC 27.

Add the following routing of NC 27 south and in Buies Creek:

US 421-NC 27 from SR 1006, northward to existing NC 27.
