BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION  
HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (See 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 20-141 (i).

TRUCK ROUTES

TOWN OF STONEVILLE

"NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that the following sections of highways shall be designed as the "truck route", said truck route being particularly described as follows:

| <u>County</u> | <u>Loc. No.</u> | <u>Route</u>  | <u>Length (Miles)</u> | <u>Description</u>  |

| Rockingham    | TR-10           | US 220 Bypass | 5.30                  | From the intersection of US 220 Business-US 220 Bypass, south of Stoneville, north along US 220 Bypass to the north intersection of US 220 Business-US 220 Bypass, north of Stoneville. |

The following section of highway shall be designated as the "other highway" and the use of said "other highway" by all through trucks and other vehicles of a gross vehicle weight in excess of 13,000 lbs. shall be prohibited; said "other highway" being particularly described as follows:

| Rockingham    | OR-10           | US 220 Business | 6.83                  | From the intersection of US 220 Bypass, south of Stoneville, northward to the north intersection of US 220 Bypass, north of Stoneville. |
