BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION

HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 136-18 (5).

NO PARKING ORDINANCES

DIVISION 10

CABARRUS COUNTY

Along the south side of SR 1157 (Wilshire Avenue) from a point 0.50 mile east of US 601 Bypass to a point approximately 0.75 mile east of US 601 Bypass.

Delete the following:

Along the south side of SR 1157 (Wilshire Avenue) from a point 0.40 mile southwest of US 601 Business, northeastward for 0.16 mile to the western corporate limit, approximately 0.16 mile southwest of Spring Street.
