Dear Mr. Huneycutt:


You had requested reasonable access for twin trailers between your facility in Albemarle and the Yellow Freight System terminal in Troy. This route which runs from your facility in Albemarle, Stanly County primarily along NC 24-27 to Troy in Montgomery County does not qualify under the rules set forth for reasonable access. Reasonable access gives trucking firms access from a National Truck Network road to their trucking terminals. The requested route is from one facility to another, not from a National Truck Network route. The requested route also does not adjoin a National Truck Network route. Therefore, we must deny this specific request. Regardless, the bridge over the Pee Dee River has only nine foot lanes and would not be approved for twin trailer use.

There is, however, an alternate route which we do approve. US 52 north of Albemarle is a National Truck Network route. Your Albemarle facility is within three miles of this "designated" route and formal DOT approval for twin trailer travel is therefore not needed for the routing between your facility and US 52. From US 52, twin trailers may then be routed northward along US 52 to NC 49, another National Truck Network route, then northward along NC 49 to NC 109 in Davidson County, then along NC 109 to SR 1141 in Montgomery County, then along SR 1141 to the Yellow Freight System terminal in Troy. This routing is approved for twin trailer use for your firm.

Mr. Fraser Huneycutt
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All weight limit restrictions that may exist on the approved route must be observed.




