HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

The State Traffic Engineer is subdelegated the authority by the Secretary of Transportation to adopt and promulgate all necessary rules, regulations and ordinances for the use of and to police traffic on state highways, and to set, change, or extend route numbers on the Primary highway system of North Carolina pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the State Traffic Engineer hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 136-18 (5), 136-89.58 and 20-161.

FORSYTH COUNTY

ORDINANCE NUMBER 330100104

TEMPORARY NO PARKING/TOW AWAY ZONE

It is hereby ordained that parking is prohibited on I-40 from a point 0.15 mile west of SR 1103 eastward to a point 0.30 mile west of SR 1122 in Forsyth County, Project Number 8.1610402 (I-0911C), and, furthermore, any vehicles parked, left standing or disabled, whether attended or unattended, on the right-of-way of I-26 within the project limits as described above shall be subject to being towed without advance notice as determined by the North Carolina Department of Transportation to a site designated by the North Carolina Department of Transportation. This ordinance shall become null and void upon completion of said project. Length of said No Parking/Tow-Away Zone is 2.98 miles.
