

NORTH CAROLINA BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION  
HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation is authorized to pre-empt the regulation of parking on State Highway System streets pursuant to G.S. 136-18 (5). The Board of Transportation is further authorized to promulgate rules and regulations pursuant to G.S. 143B-350 (f) and (g).

The North Carolina Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) and 19ANCAC 4A.0004.

The State Traffic Engineer, North Carolina Department of Transportation, is subdelegated the authority by the Secretary of Transportation to adopt and promulgate all necessary rules, regulations, and ordinances for the use of and to police traffic on state highways, pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) and 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the State Traffic Engineer, North Carolina Department of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinance.

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED PARKING ORDINANCE

100 NEW BERN PLACE, RALEIGH

It is hereby ordained that public parking is prohibited and restricted on Monday, June 10th, 1996 in the 100 block of New Bern Place as follows:

The entire south side of the 100 block of New Bern Place consisting of 26 parking spaces between Wilmington Street and Blount Street (except for space 13 which has been reserved for parking for the shuttle van and space 25 which has been reserved for parking for the handicapped) are reserved for parking by Members of the Transit 2001 Commission, Appointed by the Governor in connection with the Transit 2001 Commission Meeting scheduled for June 10, 1996, in the Highway Building. The reserved parking area shall be appropriately marked and no other parking shall be permitted while so marked except by Members of the Transit 2001 Commission.

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED PARKING ORDINANCE


It shall be unlawful for any other person, except for Transit 2001 Commission Members, to park in the spaces so designated and marked. It shall be unlawful for any unauthorized person to remove the markings reserving the parking spaces.

Except for the parking spaces designated by this Ordinance, no other parking on the 100 block of New Bern Place is affected by this Ordinance. This Ordinance is effective this the 10th, day of June, 1996.

The foregoing Highway Traffic Ordinances are hereby adopted in accordance with the General Statutes of North Carolina (G.S. 136-18 (5); 143B-350 (f), 143B-350 (g) and 19ANCAC 4A.0004). The Highway Traffic Ordinances herein adopted are identified as follows:
