

BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION
HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

The State Traffic Engineer is subdelegated the authority by the Secretary of Transportation to adopt and promulgate all necessary rules, regulations and ordinances for the use of and to police traffic on state highways, and to set, change, or extend route numbers on the Primary highway system of North Carolina pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 g), (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the State Traffic Engineer hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 20-141 (i), 20-116 (h) and 136-18 (5).

TRUCK ROUTES

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that said truck route ordinance is amended to add the following section of highway as a designated "truck route", said truck route being particularly described as follows:

<u>County</u>	<u>Route</u>	<u>Length (Miles)</u>	<u>Description</u>
Catawba	US 321	3.85	From the southern corporate limits of Newton, a point 0.21 mile north of SR 1927, to the northern corporate limit of Newton at SR 1162.
Catawba	NC 16N	0.53	From NC 10/NC 16 to NC 16S a point 0.53 mile north of NC 10/NC 16.
Catawba	NC 16S	0.49	From NC 10/NC 16 to NC 16N, a point 0.49 mile north of NC 10/NC 16.
Catawba	NC 16	1.98	From NC 16 N&S split to SR 1162.

<u>County</u>	<u>Route</u>	<u>Length (Miles)</u>	<u>Description</u>
Catawba	NC 16	0.33	From NC 10 to the eastern corporate limit of Newton, a point 0.33 mile east of NC 10.
Catawba	NC 10	3.50	From the western corporate limit of Newton, a point 0.20 mile west of SR 1005, to NC 16S.
Catawba	NC 10/NC 16	0.85	From NC 16S to NC 16, a point 0.08 mile east of SR 1880.
Catawba	NC 10	0.57	From NC 16 to the eastern corporate limit of Newton, a point 0.57 mile east of NC 16.
Catawba	SR 1005	1.61	From the southern corporate limit of Newton, a point 0.03 mile south of SR 2057, to the northern corporate limits of Newton, a point 0.13 mile north of SR 1149.
Catawba	SR 1780	2.13	From US 321 to the eastern corporate limit of Newton, a point 0.76 mile east of SR 1746.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all through trucks and other vehicles with an axle load limit in excess of 13,000 lbs. shall be restricted to US and NC numbered routes within the corporate limit of the City of Newton.
