
This is in further reference to your request for STAA reasonable access from the Coca Cola Enterprises DBA Mid Atlantic Coca Cola Bottling Company terminal in Elizabeth City to a Seamark Foods terminal in Nags Head, Dare County. During the course of our investigation, this route was discussed with you, and it was determined that the terminal location for Coca Cola Enterprises would be relocated from the Seamark Foods terminal at Mall Drive in Nags Head northward to the Dare Center in Kill Devil Hills. Our investigation is complete, and we have found the revised route to be acceptable and hereby grant approval for your firm to run STAA dimensioned vehicles along this route. The approved route is described as follows:

US 158 from US 17 Bypass in Elizabeth City, Pasquotank County, east and south to the Dare Center on Third Street in Kill Devil Hills, Dare County.

All weight limits that may exist on this route must be observed.






