
Our investigation of your request to amend the previously approved STAA reasonable access route to the Carolina Food Processors Plant north of Tar Heel is complete. We have found the amended route to be acceptable and hereby grant approval for your firm to run STAA dimensioned vehicles along this route. The approved amended route is described below.

- **NC 41 from SR 1191 east to NC 131, then north on NC 131 to NC 87, then north on NC 87 to the Carolina Food Processors Plant in Tar Heel, Bladen County.**

The previously approved portion of the route on SR 1191 from NC 41 to NC 87, then north on NC 87 to the Carolina Food Processors Plant in Tar Heel is hereby revoked, and may no longer be used by STAA vehicles. All weight limits that may exist on the amended route must be observed.






