
Our investigation of your two STAA reasonable access route requests to David Sides Tree Farms in Alleghany County is complete. At this time, we have found both routes to be acceptable by traffic engineering standards and hereby grant approval for your firm to run STAA dimensioned vehicles along these routes. The approved routes are described as follows:

- **STAA Reasonable Access Route Application Number 2059-1:** US 21 from I-77 in Surry County, northward through Wilkes County into Alleghany County through Sparta to US 221, then southwest on US 221 to SR 1161, then south on SR 1161 to SR 1163, then east on SR 1163 to David Sides Tree Farms loading area. Also includes SR 1138 (C.C. Camp Road) from I-77 in Surry County, westbound to US 21 Bypass (access to US 21 Bypass from southbound I-77).
- **STAA Reasonable Access Route Application Number 2059-2:** US 21/221 from the North Carolina-Virginia state line south to US 221, then southwest on US 221 to SR 1161, then south on SR 1161 to SR 1163, then east on SR 1163 to David Sides Tree Farms loading area.

All weight limits that may exist on these routes must be observed.





