
Our investigation of your three STAA reasonable access route requests to Bruner Sides Nursery in Alleghany County is complete. At this time, we have found these routes to be acceptable by traffic engineering standards and hereby grant approval for your firm to run STAA dimensioned vehicles along these routes. The approved routes are described as follows:

- **STAA Reasonable Access Route Application Number 2058-1**: US 21 from I-77 in Surry County, northward through Wilkes County into Alleghany County through Sparta to SR 1135, then west on SR 1135 to Bruner Sides Nursery. Also includes SR 1138 (C.C. Camp Road) from I-77 in Surry County, westbound to US 21 Bypass (access to US 21 Bypass from southbound I-77).
- **STAA Reasonable Access Route Application Number 2058-2**: US 21/221 from the North Carolina-Virginia state line south to US 221, then southwest on US 221 to Bruner Sides Nursery.
- **STAA Reasonable Access Route Application Number 2058-3**: US 21/221 from the North Carolina-Virginia state line south to US 221, then south on US 21 to SR 1135, then west on SR 1135 to Bruner Sides Nursery.

All weight limits that may exist on these routes must be observed.





Alleghany County




