

BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION
HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

The State Traffic Engineer is subdelegated the authority by the Secretary of Transportation to adopt and promulgate all necessary rules, regulations and ordinances for the use of and to police traffic on state highways, and to set, change, or extend route numbers on the Primary highway system of North Carolina pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 g), (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the State Traffic Engineer hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statutes 136-18(5), 20-146.2 and 20-176.

TRANSITWAY DESIGNATION

Now, therefore, be it hereby ordained that the following lanes of travel shall be designated as transit lanes and the use of said lanes shall be reserved for public transportation vehicles only and emergency (fire, police and ambulance) vehicles and maintenance vehicles of the North Carolina Department of Transportation and the Charlotte Department of Transportation.

County	Route	Length (Miles)	Description
Mecklenburg	US 74 (Independence Boulevard)	2.88	Centermost lanes located between the eastbound and westbound lanes of US 74 (Independence Boulevard) from a point 0.08 mile east of SR 4873 (Independence Boulevard), eastward to Westchester Boulevard, a point 0.34 mile east of SR 2940 (Eastway Drive).
