Our investigation of your STAA reasonable access route request for Yellow Transportation is complete.


This route was previously approved on March 31, 1989 for the WestPoint Pepperell terminal. It is our understanding that WestPoint Pepperell was purchased by Penco Products; therefore, the terminal location is the same. Once a route is approved, it remains in effect unless we subsequently determine it is an unsafe route. Therefore, the following route is approved.

Reasonable Access Request 2080-1: NC 903 from US 64 northward to NC 125, then northward on NC 125 to the Penco Products terminal located at 1301 Penco Drive in Hamilton, Martin County.

All weight limits that may exist on this route must be observed.
