Dear Mr. Aycock:

Our investigation of your two STAA reasonable access route requests to the W.T.S. Express terminal located at 176 Northeast Church Road in Wayne County is complete. At this time, we have found both routes to be acceptable by traffic engineering standards and hereby grant approval for your firm to run STAA dimensioned vehicles along these routes. The approved routes are described as follows:

Reasonable Access Request No. 2086-1: US 117 from US 70 in Goldsboro, Wayne County southward to NC 55; then eastward on NC 55 to US 117 Alternate; then northward on US 117 Alternate to SR 1941 (Northeast Church Road); then eastward on SR 1941 (Northeast Church Road) to the W.T.S. Express terminal located at 176 Northeast Church Road in Wayne County.


Reasonable Access Request No. 2086-2: (US 117 Connector) NC 403 from I-40 in Sampson County northward to SR 1783; then northward on SR 1783 becoming SR 1417 in Duplin County, then northeastward on SR 1417 to US 117 in Calypso, Duplin County, then northward on US 117 to NC 55 in Wayne County; then eastward on NC 55 to US 117 Alternate, then northward on US 117 Alternate to SR 1941 (Northeast Church Road), then eastward on SR 1941 (Northeast Church Road) to the W.T.S. Express terminal located at 176 Northeast Church Road in Wayne County.

All weight limits that may exist on these routes must be observed.




