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Route Changes

The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S 143B-350 (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

The State Traffic Engineer is subdelegated the authority by the Secretary of Transportation to adopt and promulgate all necessary rules, regulations and ordinances for the use of and to police traffic on state highways, and to set, change, or extend route numbers on the Primary Highway System of North Carolina pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S 143B-350(g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the State Traffic Engineer hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 136-30, 136-54.

General description of request (starting/ending points, etc.):

Extend NC 211 from its current terminus 0.133 mile east of SR 1528 (Moore Street) near Southport, Brunswick County, along the Southport - Fort Fisher ferry to US 421 1.26 miles south of SR 1713 (Loggerhead Road), near Fort Fisher, New Hanover County.

Reason/Justification for this route change:

NC 211 currently ends east of SR 1528 in Brunswick County at the Southport ferry terminal. Extending the route would allow NC 211 to end at another primary route and provide a "marine highway" for the Ferry Division, which is useful for expedited dredging operations in emergency situations.



Sterling,

I spoke with Kevin Lacy about extending primary routes across the ferries as we discussed on Tuesday. He is agreeable with extending the following:

- NC 615 from Knott's Island to NC 168, Currituck County
- NC 45 from Swan Quarter to Ocracoke, Hyde County
- NC 211 from Southport to Fort Fisher, Brunswick and New Hanover Counties

I also asked him about providing routes for the emergency ferries from Stumpy Point to Rodanthe and Hatteras, but we are reluctant to add anything to the system since they are not operational except in emergencies, there is no logical route to consider for extension, and we are under a mandate to curtail our NC route mileage.

I will begin processing these requests and will advise Div. 3 of this action. PLMK of any questions or concerns.

Jeff,

NC-45 in Hyde County is ~ 33.24 miles from the intersection with NC-45/SR-1128 and the intersection with NC-12. I had to take some artistic license with the route since most of it is, well, a ferry route... I have spoken with the Division 1 GIS tech who is riding all the ferry boats in NC with a GPS unit as part of another project. He's planning to give us the data from that project for incorporation into the LRS, so we'll have much better ferry routes. As good as you can map an over water route I guess.

NC-615 in Currituck County - .33 miles.

NC-211 in Brunswick and New Hanover Counties - ~ 3.80 miles in Brunswick and ~ .35 miles in New Hanover for a total mileage of ~ 4.15 miles. The same artistic license was taken with this route that was used for NC-45...

Ryan, I left the linework used to get these numbers in the draft linework feature class, so you can take advantage of my awesome art skills when it's time to process these. At least the numbers will match up that way.
